MANUAL 3 PROCEDURE FOLLOWED IN DECISION-MAKING [Section 4 (1)(b)(iii)]

1. Process of decision making Identify key decision making points

- **1.** <u>Institution Administration:</u> Administrative decisions related to the institution are taken by Head of the Institution, namely Campus Director/Principal.
- **2.** <u>Financial</u>: Financial decisions are taken as per financial rules and up to the extent of the powers delegated by DSEU/DTTE to various levels of hierarchy in the Department.
- **3.** <u>Academic</u>: Academic policy decisions are taken at the level of DSEU/DTTE, BTE, AICTE & other allied agencies

2. Final decision making authority

- 1. <u>Institution Administration:</u> Campus Director/Principal
- **2.** <u>Financial</u>: Financial decisions are taken up to the extent of the powers delegated by DSEU/DTTE to various levels of hierarchy in the Department.
- 3. Academic: DSEU/DTTE

3. Related provisions, acts, rules etc.

- 1. Institution Administration: As per the guidelines of DSEU/DTTE
- **2. Financial**: As per General Financial Rules (GFR)
- **3.** Academic: As per guidelines of BTE and AICTE.

4. Time limit for taking a decision, if any

- 1. The time limit for taking decision depends on power delegated to the official.
- **2.** If the matter is within the power of Campus Director/Principal, the decision is taken in a stipulated time.
- **3.** If the matter beyond the power of Campus Director/Principal, the decision is taken after getting approval from competent authority.

5. Channel of supervision and accountability

- **1.** <u>Institution Administration:</u> Administrative officer/Office Superintendent Campus Director/Principal DSEU/DTTE
- 2. <u>Financial</u>: DDO/AAO Campus Director/Principal DSEU/DTTE
- **3.** <u>Academic</u>: HOD Campus Director/Principal DSEU/DTTE/BTE
